A YOUNG CITY OF CULTURE

35,000 students of the 3 local universities live in Würzburg, making it a young and active city. You have a great variety of ways to spend your leisure time: visit one of the 12 theatres, 16 museums and galleries, or stroll through our traditional German Christmas Market, the two Oktoberfest-style beer festivals or our exciting city and wine festivals. Würzburg also hosts hundreds of concerts from classical to independent, as well as Europe's largest Africa Festival.

NO TUITION FEES AND EXCELLENT PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

With no tuition fees, it's easy to finance your studies in Würzburg and the *Semesterticket* allows you to use public transportation as often as you like for your ride to the university or to explore the gorgeous surroundings of Würzburg.

FINANCING YOUR STUDIES

Cost of living is relatively low and it is easy to find a student job. Students from the EU are permitted to work up to 20 hours weekly during their studies.
