

Accommodation

Students of the University of Augsburg can choose between many types of accommodation. The university itself does not provide any halls of residence: nevertheless, it cooperates very closely with the organization "Studentenwerk", which manages five dorms in Augsburg.

In general, however, students in Augsburg live in shared apartments (usually not furnished). The rental prices are relatively low in comparison for example to Munich. The internet (e.g. www.wggesucht.de), or the university's bulletin boards are great sources for finding shared apartments.




